- To submit an abstract, you must be a CHES member. Individuals may become CHES members by completing the form at www.ches.med.ubc.ca.
- Members may be the presenting author on **one abstract** only.
- Abstracts will be reviewed for clarity, categorization, and scheduling purposes.
- Members may present work previously presented at other conferences.
- Members may present work in progress.
- Members are requested to identify their preference for a poster presentation or an oral presentation. The final program and format assignment is contingent upon the number of submissions in each category.

RESEARCH ABSTRACTS

- Abstracts should be a maximum of 250 words.
- Abstracts should conform to the following structure:
 - » INTRODUCTION
 - » METHODS
 - » RESULTS
 - » DISCUSSION
- Abstracts should include three keywords

INNOVATION ABSTRACTS

- Abstracts should be a maximum of 250 words.
- Abstracts should conform to the following structure:
 - » WHAT PROBLEM WAS ADDRESSED?
 - » WHAT WAS TRIED?
 - » WHAT LESSONS WERE LEARNED?
- Abstracts should include three keywords
